4. MUGA Flooring

- Council are doing a condition survey for the 2020-2023 plan once the capital programme is approved. Change from what was understood.
- Decided it is best to wait and see how Milton is ranked, at the end of January 2020.

5. Head teachers Report

- Parking - wardens came on the 12th Nov. They informed the school that only buses (coaches and double deckers) were legally allowed to park in the bus bay. And if any non bus vehicles were parked there at the end of school they would be ticketed. Therefore the school decided to allow the school transport to park in the school carpark.
- The new system works better so will continue. Parents if early can use any empty spaces. The drop off will be left for the school transport.

6. Head teachers discussion topics

- Lockerbie - discussion about length, cost etc to allow school to plan for next year.
- Golden Time - not meeting all childrens needs so discussion about alternatives, link to house points, plan to use pupil natter to discuss with pupils, need to allow learning. A system that rewards rather than removes preferred.
- Library Launch - each class getting half hour slots to use for literacy time.
