Changes to Self-Isolation Guidance - Effective from 6/1/22 (added 6/1/22 by Mrs James)

As you are aware, the First Minister gave an update in the Scottish Parliament yesterday about the impact of Covid as we begin the new year. We also heard of the changes to self-isolation periods which are based on scientific and medical advice and are effective from midnight on 5 January 2022. The changes to self-isolation guidance are summarised below and are effective from the start of the school day on Thursday, 6 January 2022.

Positive cases are advised to self-isolate for 10 days. However, if the individual returns two consecutive negative LFD tests taken at least 24 hours apart with the first test no earlier than day 6 they may end isolation before the end of the 10 day period if they have no fever.

Close contacts who are fully vaccinated, having received 3 doses of the vaccination (plus 14 days) or are aged under 18 years and 4 months, can take daily LFD tests for 7 days instead of isolation - provided the tests are negative and they remain without symptoms. If someone has not received 3 doses of the vaccination, they will need to book a PCR test and even if this is a negative result, they will need to isolate for 10 days.

Advice on confirmatory PCR tests where people test positive on a lateral flow device (LFD) test they are now not advised to get a PCR test to confirm infection, but to follow isolation advice as it applies to them as a positive case (see positive case point) – there is an exception for people who may be eligible for the Self-Isolation Support Grant who are advised to take a PCR test to ensure they can confirm their infection to be potentially eligible for financial support.
